

Notice of Urgent Decisions to be made by the Executive on 29 July 2020

General Exception Regulation 10 Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012.

Under the Regulations, local authorities are required to publish a Notice of Key Decisions to be made by the Executive at least 28 days clear before the meeting. Where this is not possible the decision may be made where the Scrutiny Committee Chairman has been informed, notice is given and at least 5 clear days have elapsed before the decision is made.
